An ice sheet that covers most of Antarctica is about 1.34 miles thick. To the nearest tenth of a mile, how thick is the ice? Round 1.34 to the nearest tenth.

The digit in the tenths place is 3.

Look at the digit to the right of 3.

4 is less than 5

 $\mathfrak{Z}$  So, keep the 3 and drop the digit to its right, 4.

So, the thickness of the ice rounded to the nearest tenth is 1.3 miles.
